LEVEL 3 LAW (University Foundation Level)

The UK legal services market is worth £26.8bn. It employs up to 320,000 people in England and Wales alone and contributes a net £3bn to the UK's balance of trade.

The Level 3 Diploma in Law is a 60 credit qualification and is equivalent to an A-Level or Access to HE Qualification. It has been designed for learners who wish to progress to study a law degree, but may not have the traditional entry qualifications usually required.

The qualification provides learners with an introduction to law and the legal system as well as key academic, research and communication skills to support learners in their development. It provides progression to the BA (Hons) in Law (LLB) plus a range of other degrees in law related subjects. Learners will complete 4 mandatory units worth 60 credits to achieve the Level 3 Diploma in Law.
