The Level 5 Extended Diploma in Law is a 120-credit qualification and is equivalent to the second year of a UK degree programme. It has been designed for learners who wish to progress to study a law degree, but may not have the traditional entry qualifications usually required. It also prepares learners well for the forthcoming Solicitors Qualifying Examination.

The qualification will equip learners with an in-depth knowledge and understanding in a number of key areas, allowing learners to progress within their careers or, alternatively, completion will support progression to LLB top-up programmes at UK Universities, as well a range of other degrees in law-related subjects. Learners will complete 4 mandatory units worth 30 credits each to achieve the Level 5 Extended Diploma in Law.
